Yokefellow is a Listening Ministry

- ◇ Small group discussions facilitated by volunteers
- ◇ Inmates choose the topic
- ◇ Discuss feelings and emotions, such as pain, loneliness, and isolation
- ◇ Inmates receive the gift of "being heard"
- ◇ Relational evangelism fosters an environment of forgiveness, acceptance, and belonging
