DISCIPLINES

3. **The Discipline of Worship.** To participate, at least once a week, in the public worship of God.
4. **The Discipline of Money.** To return to God a definite portion of my income to support the Christian cause.
5. **The Discipline of Service.** To allot a specific amount of my time in humble acts of love and service to others.
6. **The Discipline of Witness.** To make an unapologetic witness in daily life, daily work, and daily words.
7. **The Discipline of Study.** To become a better-informed Christian by careful study of Christian books.
